Hey, you're the one who kissed Marlon Brando on the lips! You tell me which TV event was tougher to watch!



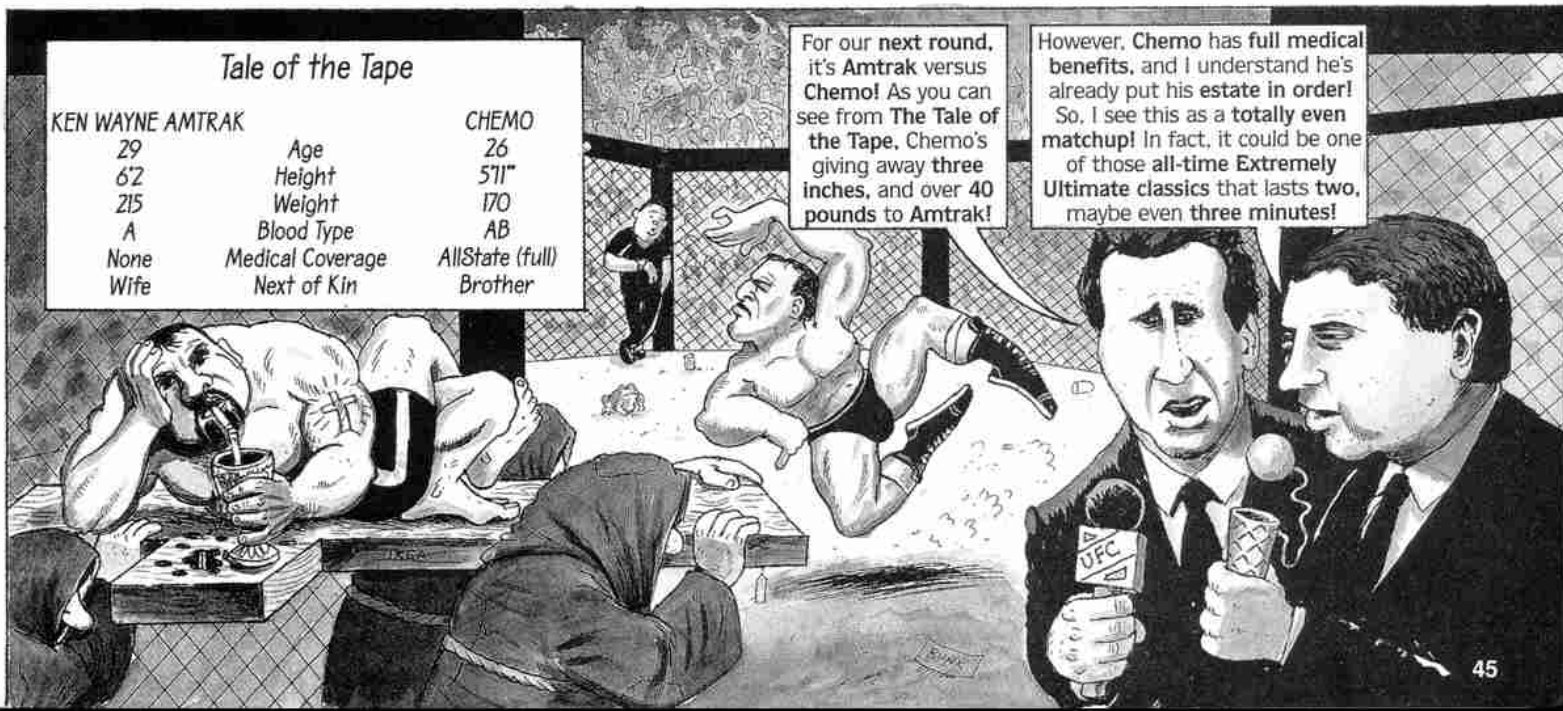
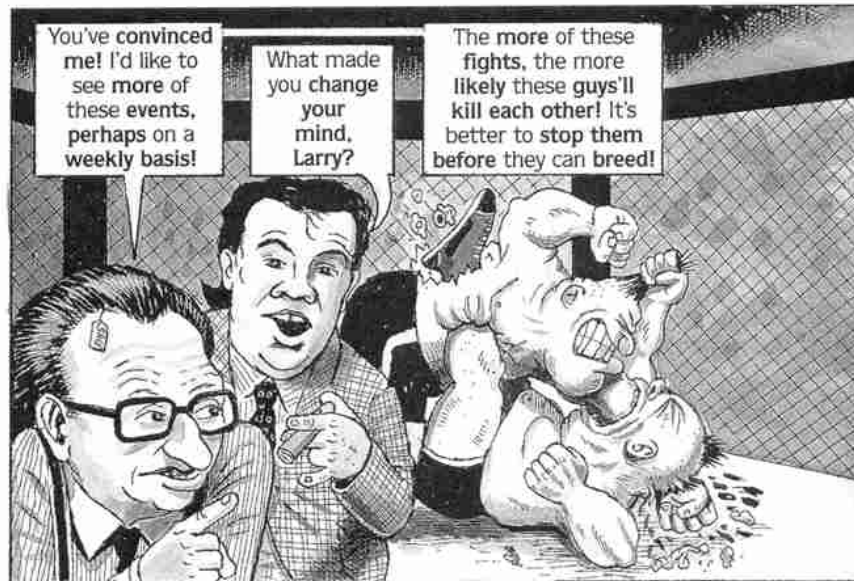
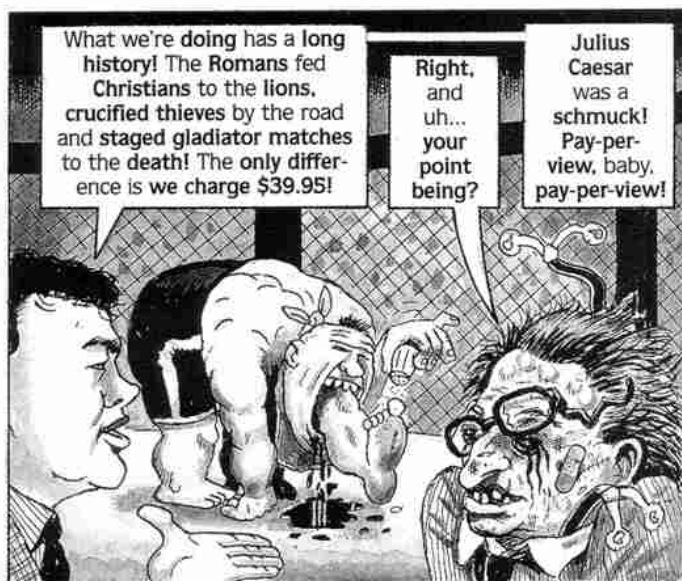
