
FRED DENBY WARMING UP FOR HIS NBA DEBUT TONIGHT WITH MICHAEL JORDAN AND COMPANY.




Scene at the payout window at Churchill Downs yesterday. The number four horse, "Lucky Dan," was the only winner. Many confused bettors thought otherwise.

CHURCHILL DOWNS, Kentucky, May 10 (Reuters) — Over one hundred racing fans received minor injuries yesterday when hyperexcited bettors stormed the payout windows immediately following the running of the Kentucky Derby. Virtually all of the fans thought they heard their horse announced as the winner of the prestigious race.

The head of the Kentucky National Guard stated today that the cause of the riot has been traced to track announcer Johnny Blodgett, Blodgett, who suffers from a severe speech impediment had only recently been hired to announce the races after the track lost a lawsuit seeking to bar Blodgett from the job due to his handicap.

"No one can understand the guy," one track official, who requested anonymity remarked. "But the law of the land said we couldn't discriminate against anyone for a physical defect. So when Blodgett applied, we had no choice but to give him the job. It was a time bomb waiting to happen and it happened yesterday."

CIRCUS TRAGEDY KILLS 50 LITTLE PEOPLE

POLICE BLAME 250 LB. "MIDGET"

SANDUSKY, Ohio, Nov. 1 (AP) — Fifty midget circus clowns suffocated to death during a performance last night when the door of their tiny clown car was blocked by a 250-pound so-called midget performer.

Circus authorities identified the overweight clown as John Jakes, aka Jolly Joe. Jakes had just joined the circus after a land-mark court decision against weight and height discrimination that stated he could not be denied a job with little people because of his massive size.

"Yeah, the whole thing could have been avoided," claimed an unidentified sideshow geek who witnessed the tragedy, "had that fat freak not insisted on being the first one out of the car." Ambulances rushed to the scene

GROSS INCOMPETENCE DELAYS ROCKET LAUNCHING Bumbling Technician has Trouble with Countdown

CAPE CANAVER-AL, Fla., July 17 - The launching of the space shuttle Atlantis was postponed indefinitely yesterday after a bewildered NASA technician had trouble counting down backwards from 10.

Randy Grooms, a NASA space program specialist, has been blamed for the delay in the current space mission. Grooms joined NASA after a federal appeals court found in his favor in an I.Q. discrimination suit that ruled no one can be denied employment because of intelligence.


The unusually high concentration of silicon found in Martian rocks is seen nowhere on Earth except on Sunset Blvd. in Los Angeles.

Since the Sojourner is operated by an Intel microchip, NASA engineers spend the vast majority of their workday on hold with tech support.


