It all began with a boy and his dog. But implied bestiality is only a small part of the enduring appeal of Tintin. The intrepid reporter, or explorer, or whatever the hell job he's got, has been thrilling fans with his globetrotting adventures for 75 years now. That's 525 in Snowy

years...isn't it about time that

dog got put down?

Well, the world has changed. And there's no reason why a personality-free cipher like Tintin shouldn't change with it. In the first new Tintin book since 1976, the gang makes its way to wartorn Iraq, in search of stolen blueprints or some crap. The motivation is a bit hazy, as the book begins in typical Tintin mode, with all the characters falling down staircases in endlessly comic fashion. After 30 pages of this Belgian hilarity, the adventure proper begins.

Arriving at Baghdad Airport, Tintin receives his first setback when his taxi driver turns out to be a suicide bomber. Luckily, the gang escapes with just a few bumps and scrapes, not counting Snowy's massive injuries. The white pup's blindness and internal bleeding are played for big laughs later on.

Of course, it wouldn't be "Tintin" without the zany clash of cultures! When that lovable rogue Captain Haddock gets drunk in violation of Muslim law, the local authorities have no choice but to lop off his drinking hand. You can imagine the colorful language the good Captain would let loose on his punishers...if only they hadn't also seared his tongue with hot coals!

Another crazy mix-up occurs later in the story, when the bumbling Thompson twins are beheaded by their fundamentalist captors. Suffice to say

that reuniting the correct heads with the original bodies is no easy task!

But since this is fiction, the story ends cheerfully, with all the characters leaving Iraq like they said they would.

Adding it up, Tintin in Fallujah is another winner! It wrings more laughs out of the ceaseless blood-saturated nightmare than you'd expect. So even if you worship that other, ridiculous god, you're sure to love it. Let it occupy your bookshelf for the next 30 years!
