# FREAKSHOW WITH HANS BRICKFACE






Bad To The Jones — As always, our own Hans Brickface is on the case! Here's his report:




SCOOP AND KIRK HAMMET

On page 3,591 of the February/March 2004 issue, we reported that your wedding day is "the happiest day of your life." It has since been brought to our attention by several readers that this is more likely "the first day of a miserable, ever downwardspiraling existence culminating in the welcome, sweet sting of death." We regret the error.

NEINITE SECRE

DC Comics has a dozen icons that have truly stood the test of time. Unfortunately, there are another 925,000 characters in the DC Universe. That's more than the combined populations of Iceland, Tonga and Equatorial Guinea. Thus, it's no shock that after 65 years of random hackwork, not all of the stories match up. A minor detail to most adults, but a matter of crucial importance to the unmarried fanboys who wage internet flamewars because "Hawkman would never do that." To this gruesomely select audience, every issue matters. A lot. And other than wedgies, these geeks hate continuity gaps most of all. But squooshing all DC history into coherence is an impossibility, despite several retcons. ("Retcon" is a collectors' term meaning "will never touch a girl's boobie.")

Writer/artist/sadist Ethan Bello finally devised the perfect system for keeping 925,000 mismatched characters straight: kill EVERYONE! He's cranked out the most mindless mini-series in comics history, and it's a thing of beauty. No plot. No drama. Just thousands of inconvenient, not-too-familiar faces saying hello and immediately getting blasted into oblivion. Anybody remember the Silver Scarab? Well, don't bother trying; he's worm food. Lagoon Boy? Morgan Edge? Clayface? Every one of them a real DC character, and now they're all real dead.

Issue #1 starts with a bang, as we bid an emotionless farewell to Bwana Beast, Dr. Polaris, Weather Wizard, Amazo, Beppo the Super-Monkey, Cave Carson, the Ultra-Humanite, Egg-Fu, Granny Goodness, Congorilla, Floronic Man, G'nort, Shatterfist, Wonder Tot,

Killer Moth, the Newsboy Legion, Bouncing Boy, the Phantom Stranger, Chlorophyll Kid, the Kryptonian Thought-Beast, Chop-Chop, Nuklon, the Scarlet Skiier, Matter-Eater Lad, the Conquer Worms, T.O. Morrow, Major Flashback, Shade the Changing Man, Detective Chimp, and the Blue Beetle.

The second page is even bloodier.

Alas, due to space limitations, Bello could only kill off 60,000 characters per issue. Thus, a quarter-million of DC's most meaningless heroes managed to survive the carnage (including Reflecto, Sportsmaster and Zebra-Man). A sequel would appear to be the answer, except that impatient DC editors have already resurrected 320,000 of the brieflydead characters in 320,000 highlydesirable "Issue #1"s.

We can't quite recommend "ISCOAEW," since the unholy butchery does get a little "samey" by the time Bello slaughters the G's and H's. But if you ever wondered, "Whatever happened to Captain Boomerang?" this collection has the answer. He died.
