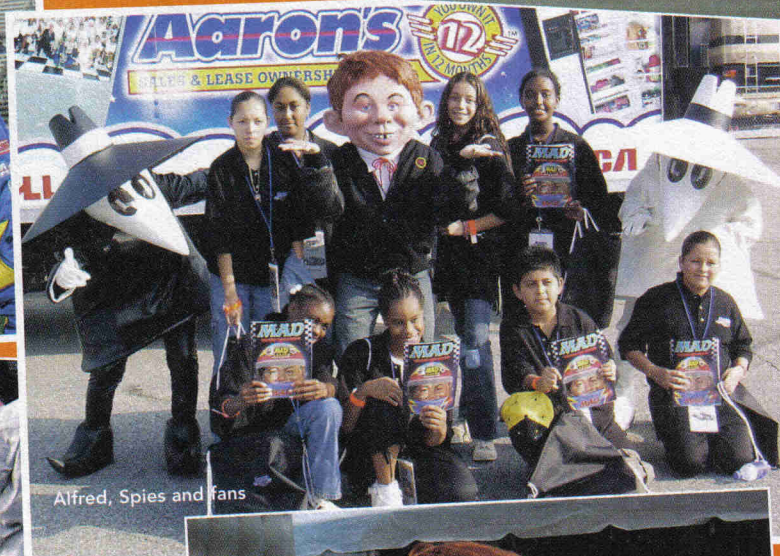

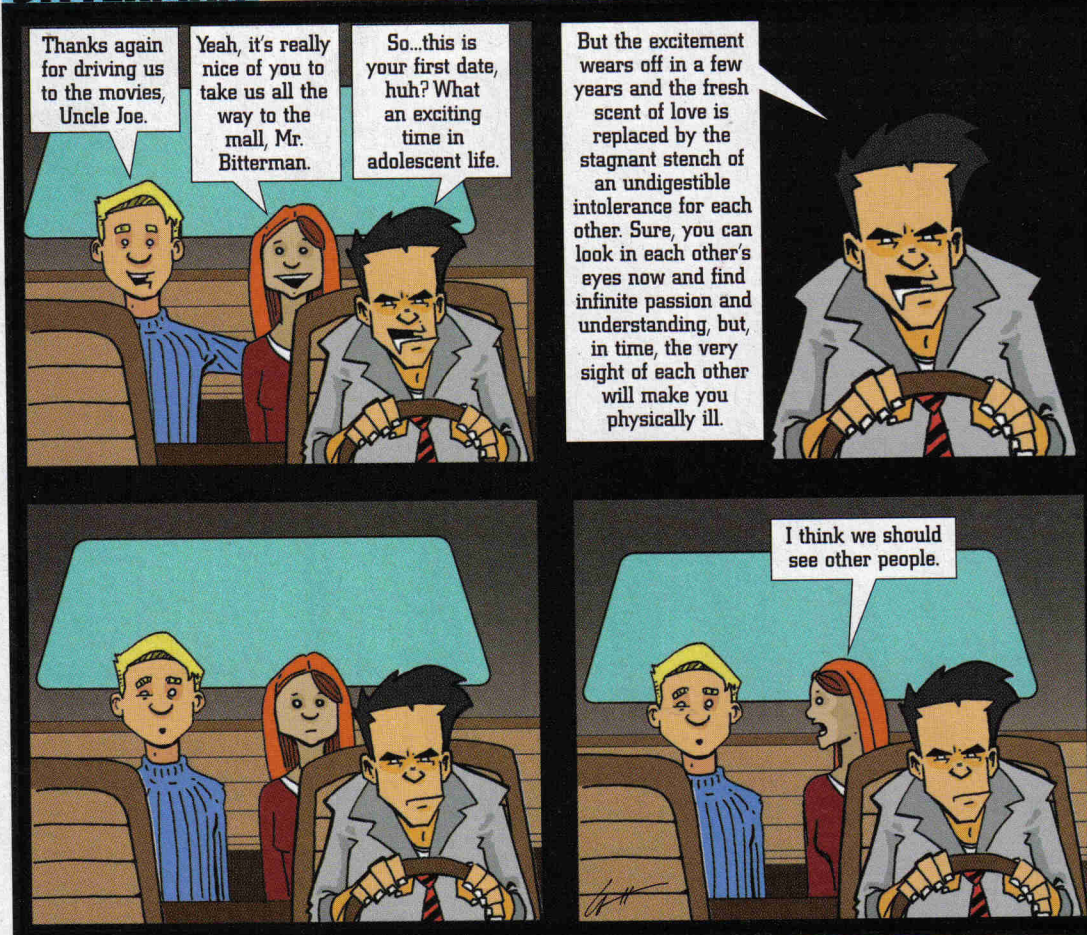


MAGAZINE CORRECTIONS YOU MAY HAVE MISSED

Of the **1%** of Americans who took up John Kerry's offer to check out his campaign platform on his website, **92%** gave up after 10 seconds to download porn.

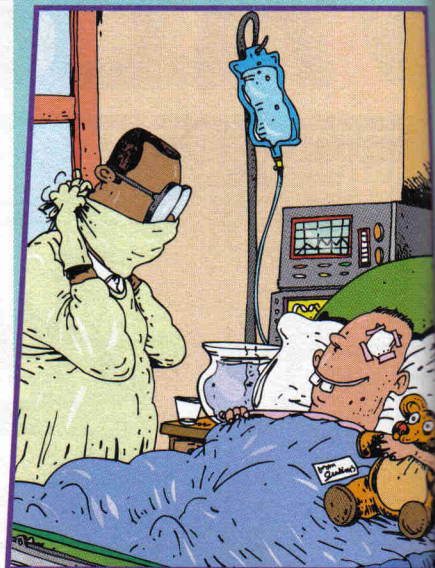
George Bush showed better than expected strength with young voters (**19%**) after they learned he was once a drug-addled, draft-dodging underachiever.
