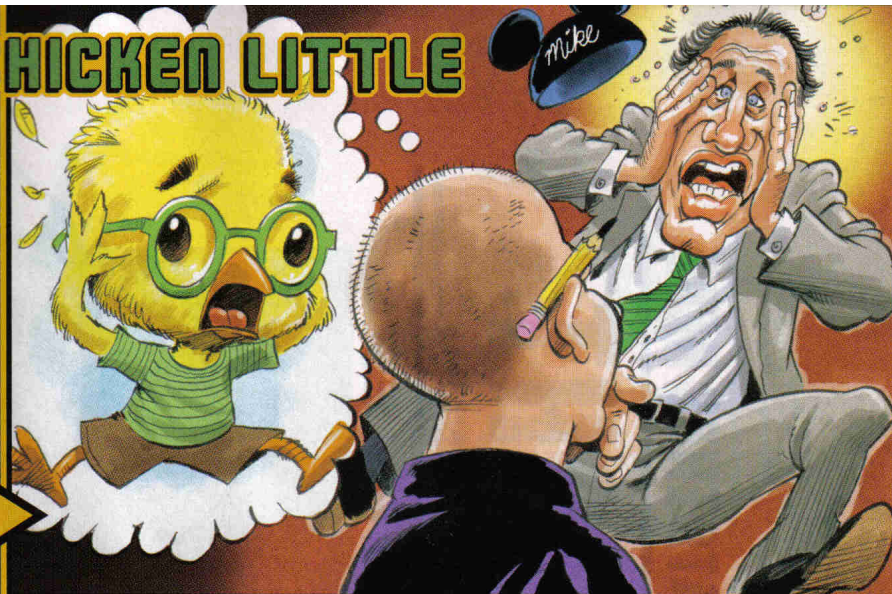
Stick around after the credits for a hilarious outtake of 50 Cent and his posse beating a hapless production assistant to within an inch of his life.

So were *Seinfeld* and *Friends*, two alleged "NYC shows"!

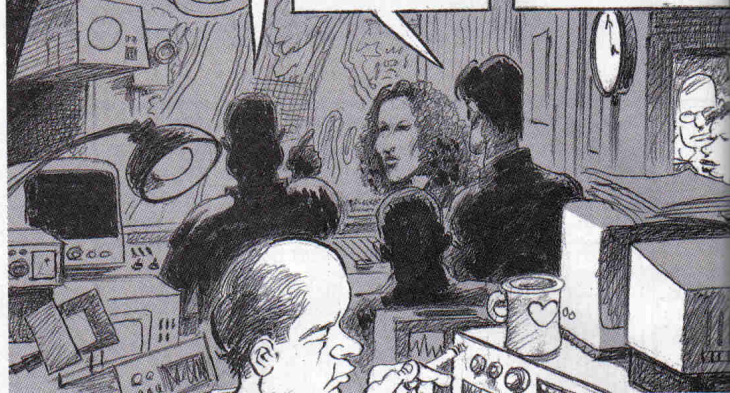
And this one *isn't*?

Carrot Top? Do you mean that obnoxious clown or David Caruso?

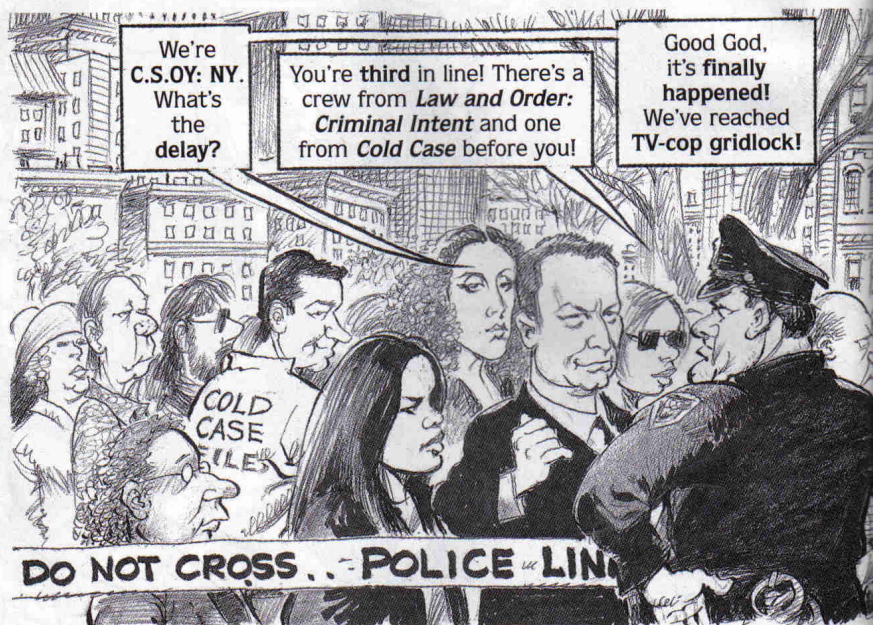
