



The opening package rolls. Lots of flags, lots of bald eagles, spacious skies, Mount Rushmore and various patriotic words spinning around through the air. It's like an erotic fever dream for George W. Bush, except for all the reading.



Colbert the talk show host is pro-war, anti-science, anti-gay, anti-immigrant, anti-Hollywood, and antievolution. It's a ridiculous absurdist parody that could never finish higher than second in the GOP New Hampshire primary.



In "The Word," a spoof of Bill O'Reilly's "Talking Points Memo." Colbert pontificates, while words projected to his side reveal the show's actual point of view. He might spout off on the Democrats' plan to set a deadline for withdrawing troops from Iraq. But the only deadline Colbert really cares about is January 21, 2009, when George W. Bush leaves office and he loses his best source of material.



On the debut show, Colbert struck gold by inventing the word "TRUTHINESS," a type of knowledge based on emotion and rhetoric without regard to facts. Later on, he unveiled "WIKIALITY," a rewritten form of truth by consensus. Unfortunately, following enthusiastic response, he soon became addicted to suffixes.
